① Check-in & Uniform

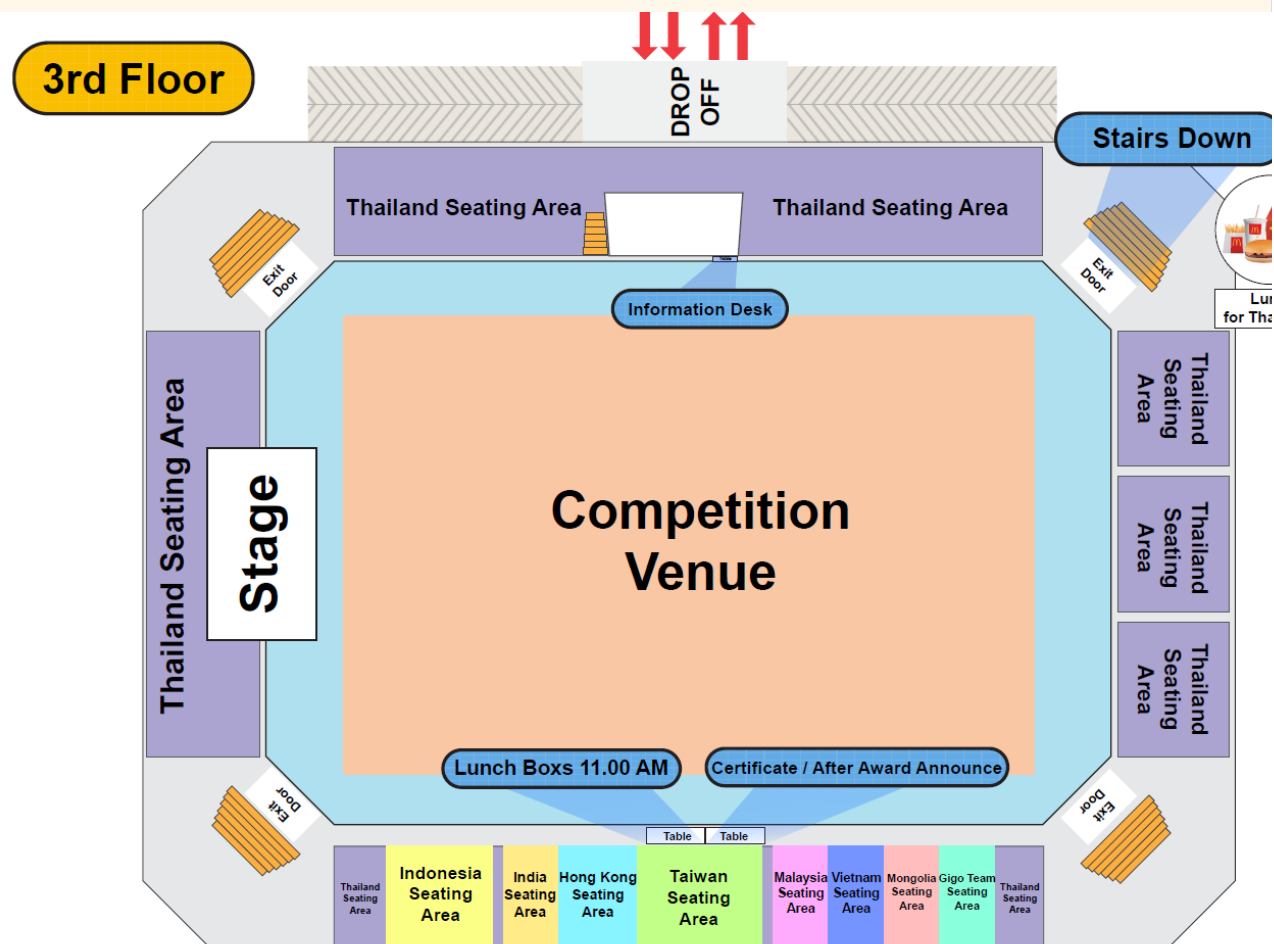
- Check-in will take place directly at each team's assigned station. Team shirts and materials will be placed at the assigned station in advance.
- Student enrollment certificates do not need to be submitted at a separate check-in desk. Staff members will visit each team's assigned station to collect them.

- Award Certificates will be distributed on-site. An organizer representative will bring the certificates to the designated table in the center of the spectator stands. Please refer to the diagram below:

- Attendees are requested to assemble at 17:10 for the Award Ceremony. This is the assembly time, not the ceremony start time.

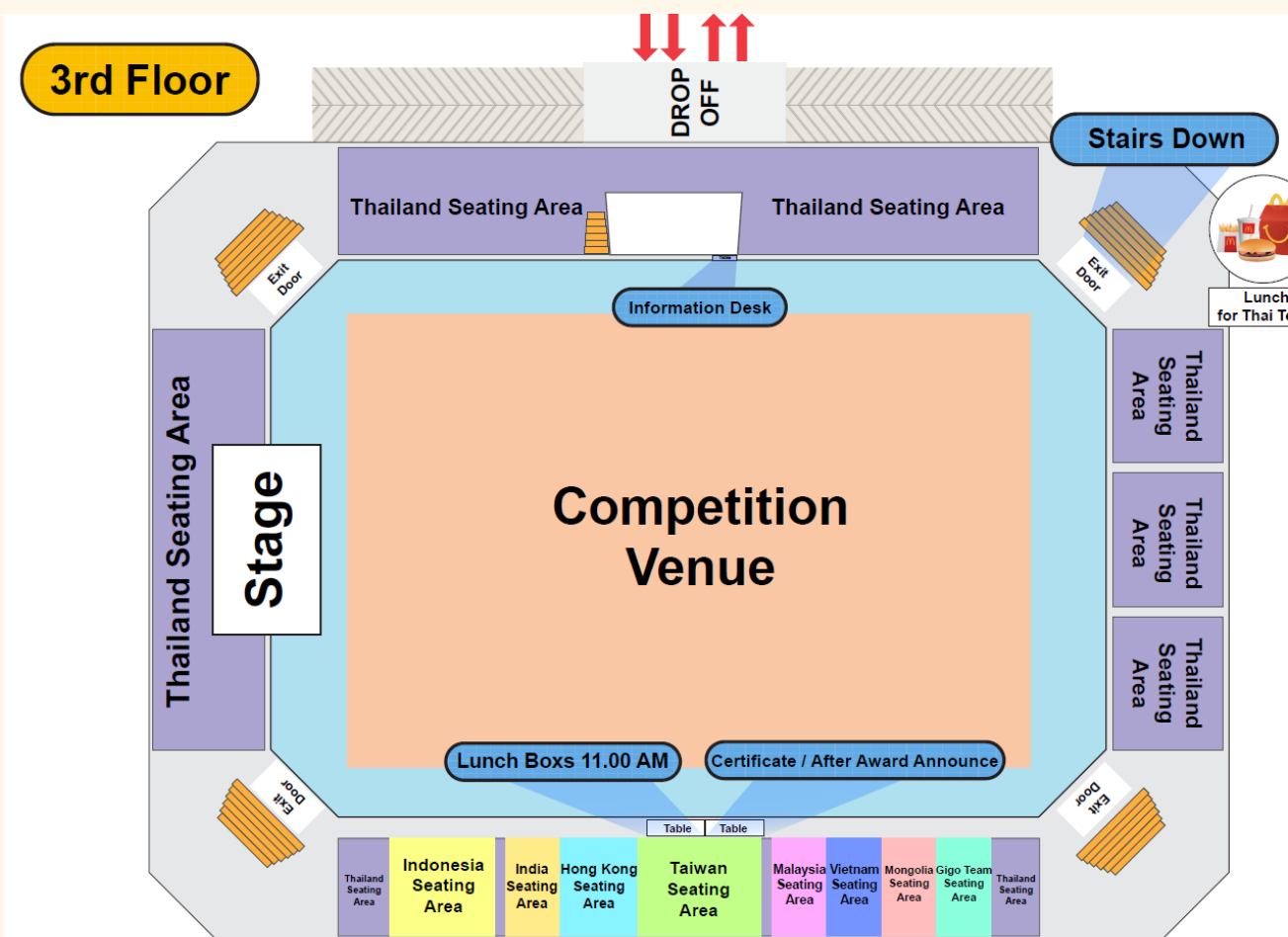
③ Team Seating & Waiting Areas

- The seating and waiting areas for participating teams are located in the spectator stands. Please refer to the layout below.



④ Lunch & Water

- Lunch boxes may be collected from the designated table located in the center of the spectator stands. The collection time will be announced separately. Each country should appoint one representative to collect the lunch boxes on behalf of its delegation. Please refer to the diagram below.



- Lunch may be consumed in the spectator stands. Each country will have its own designated seating area, as shown in the layout above.
- Lunch and drinking water will be provided only to registered participants, teachers, and parents. Two 500 mL bottles of water per person will be delivered to each country's designated seating area every morning.
- Only lunch boxes will be distributed at lunchtime. No additional bottled water will be provided, as each person will have already received two bottles in the morning.
- There are no water refill stations inside the competition area. Bottled drinking water may be purchased in the area beneath the venue.
- Bottled drinking water may be brought into the competition venue.

⑤ Meeting Family During Breaks

- During the lunch break, students may meet their teachers and parents in their country's designated seating area in the spectator stands.

⑥ Judges, Interpreters, Observers & Media

- Interpreters and observers must report to the front check-in point between 8:00 and 9:00.
- A code of conduct for media representatives will be provided separately.

⑦ Facilities & Appeals

- No Wi-Fi is available inside the stadium.
- Formal appeals may be submitted only for the Robot for Mission (R4M) and GreenMech Junior – Programmer (GMJR-P) competitions. All appeals must follow the official appeal procedure. The Chief Judge's decision is final.

⑧ GMJR Special Rules

- GMJR-S: Parents and teachers must leave the competition area by 8:25.
- GMJR-P: Parents and teachers must leave the competition area by 13:25.

⑨ Pre-Opening Ceremony Schedule

- 17:00 – Distinguished guests arrive at the venue and view the participants' projects for approximately 10 minutes.
- 17:20 – Opening ceremony performance.
- 17:30 – Remarks by distinguished guests, followed immediately by the award presentation.
